- A second paper is in the second round of revision in the journal Animal (*Impact of conservation plans on genetic variability of livestock breeds: Relevance of effective population sizes*)

## Common ambitions and further opportunities for collaboration

- New MYPOW of ERFP 2019-2024
- Options to enhance collaboration between ERFP and EAAP towards the future
- Activities of EAAP WG-AnGR e.g. joint ERFP-EAAP-FAO joint session
- Sharing information about further AnGR activity plans in each organization in order to set up greater synergies and collaborations
- External communication and networking strategy of ERFP and EAAP – synergies
- GenRes Bridge (CSA Horizon 2020) views and collaboration



#### Administrative and financial issues:

- Reduced fee/one day fee exemption for ERFP National Coordinator (or their representative) to attend the joint meeting(s) of ERFP/FAO/EAAP on AnGR – could be included in specifications/model agreement between EAAP and individual countries organizing committees
- Possibilities to lighten the administrative burden and to digitalize the ERFP reimbursement procedures (and more specifically to reduce/avoid the mandatory sending by slow mail of all the invoices – cf. document 3\_EAAP\_ERFP\_ReportingV3.doc).
- Possibilities for ERFP Secretariat to pay invoices directly (rooms registration, meals, transport, etc), e.g. by credit card, without going through payment by personal funding followed by ERFP reimbursement procedure.
