- Foundation: England, 27th June, 1991
- Form: Limited Private Company
- Foundational object:

Ensuring the **preservation of genes** of potential special value after hybridization and other actions for the benefit of mankind and the promotion of **agriculture**.

RBI PRIORITIES

- Acting as the global "umbrella" non-governmental organization (NGO) to coordinate and build on the activities of regional and national members.
- Assisting in the implementation of the Global Plan of Action for Animal Genetic Resources.
- Maintaining a communication network with partners and stakeholders, including governmental, intergovernmental and NGO bodies, to maximize cooperative efforts to conserve native animal genetic resources.

RBI ACHIEVEMENTS

- Organised International Meetings in UK, Hungary, Canada, Nepal, Brazil, South Africa, Vietnam, Turkey.
- Ad hoc conferences from 1992 in Spain to 2016 in Canada.
- RBI proposed a 'genetic impact' protocol and 'breeds at risk' criteria.
- Exchange of genetic material between NGOs (e.g. Red Poll semen from UK to South Africa).

RBI EVOLUTION

- Act as the link between governmental agencies (FAO) and grassroots activists (NGOs, groups, individuals).
