Plan of activities for 2018-2019

Continue activities on improving data quality through different approaches.

1) Ad hoc action "Indicators for monitoring status and trend of honeybees and pollination ecosystem service": recommendations for development and implementations of data fields on honeybees in DAD-IS.

2) Develop and propose a new ERFP ad hoc action on breeds adapted in specific environments (i.e. mountain environment) : this task could be used:

To improve data quality (adaptiveness, productive systems, harmonized / standardized system to describe the breeds and their distribution...)

To involve stakeholders to favour the use of EFABIS

As demonstration case (many mountain breeds are transboundary; Horizon GenRESBRIDGE)

3) Transboundary Breeds: specific focus aiming at create a network and best practices for better monitoring transboundary regional breeds, to address through the regular activities of the WG, the proposed ad hoc action and by using the synergies with the Horizon GENRESBRIDGE.

Points 2 and 3 could be merged in a multi-year proposal involving all the WGs



Plan of activities for 2018-2019

4) Collaboration/participation to GENRESBRIDGE Horizon Proposal:

- 1) to favour synergies with other domains
- 2) through the activities aiming at improving data quality within EFABIS

5) technical Workshop (addressing specific aspects of AnGR management related with the improvement of documentation and information) that could be jointly organized with FAO, in collaboration with the countries of the Mediterranean region (including the North Africa and Middle East countries). The proposal is presented in ANNEX B. Period: February –March 2019 **Expected budget 17.500 euro; request of co-funding from ERFP 5600 euro**

6) Contribute to ERFP communication strategy
