 - State of signing MoU
 - 7 countries signed MoU
 - Italy, Romania, Slovenia, Albania, Austria, Spain, Montenegro
 - 5 countries signing in progress
 - The Netherlands, Poland, Switzerland, France, Serbia
 - Obstacles of Signing MoU
 - changes in government, lack of infrastructure within the state for establishing GB or GB is just established, meeting with National Gene bank steering committee need to be organized...

 - MAA and MTA documents will be adapted to the law of each country
 - MoU should be signed with Annex

 - □ Follow-up presentation "Results of the IMAGE questionarie # genetic collections in Europe" from joint meeting with WG D&I
 - IMAGE survey →
 - acces to Genebank data are <u>limited</u>,
 - most genetic collections provide <u>link to a website</u>,
 - often no detailed information about collections
 - Relationship between EUGENA and IMAGE
 - IMAGE is a research project # suport further EUGENA work
 - IMAGE survey results will be available on IMAGE web site



- □ Part III
 - SANITARY AND VETERINARY ISSUES IN CRYO-CONSERVATION (B. Berger)
 - EU regulations on disease control may prevent use of genebank material (old samples, not accredited method,...)
 - National derogations are very important
 - Responsibility of countries contact governments
 - New methods and opportunities for diagnosis can ensure not to use infective material
 - □ In case of new or updated EU veterinary legislation → possibility for specific derogations supporting the conservation of AnGR
