On Saturday 21 August the projects coordination meeting is organized. During the meeting the on going ERFP funded projects will be presented and a discussion will follow with the participation of all European National Coordinators. Furthermore, a Round Table Discussion is organised with the participation of AnGR GENRES project leaders, with the title "GENRES follow up: ways to ensure the sustainability of the AnGR projects results".

On Sunday 22 August 2010, the Annual Workshop of the NCs will be held. The programme includes invited presentations on key topics. One of the main issues to be decided is the new business plan.
