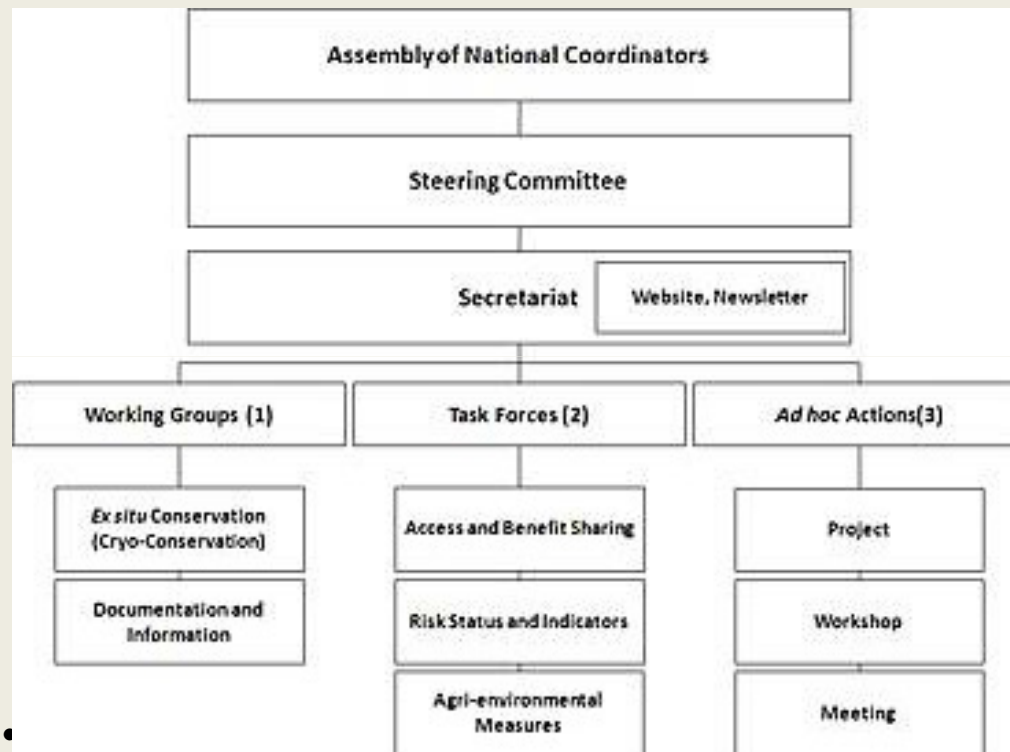


ERFP Ad hoc Action / Projects
