
#### Aim of the WG

- To regularly exchange experiences and knowledge between European countries
- To support the establishment, further development, efficiency and effectivity of national gene banks for farm animal genetic resources.
- To jointly (further) develop a European strategy for gene banking, documentation and other related issues.
- Main emphasis of the WG-ExSitu will be on cryopreservation programmes.
- The WG-ExSitu will meet at least once a year and maximum of two times per year.
