When preparing your presentation can you please include the results of your project so far in relation to the project aim, the project duration (beginning and envisaged end) and the expenses so far. The travel expenses (economy class tickets only) and accommodation for your attendance at the ERFP Assembly meeting can be paid from the remaining funds of the project you are project coordinator of, or if you are unable to attend, for the participation of one project member who will give the presentation.
