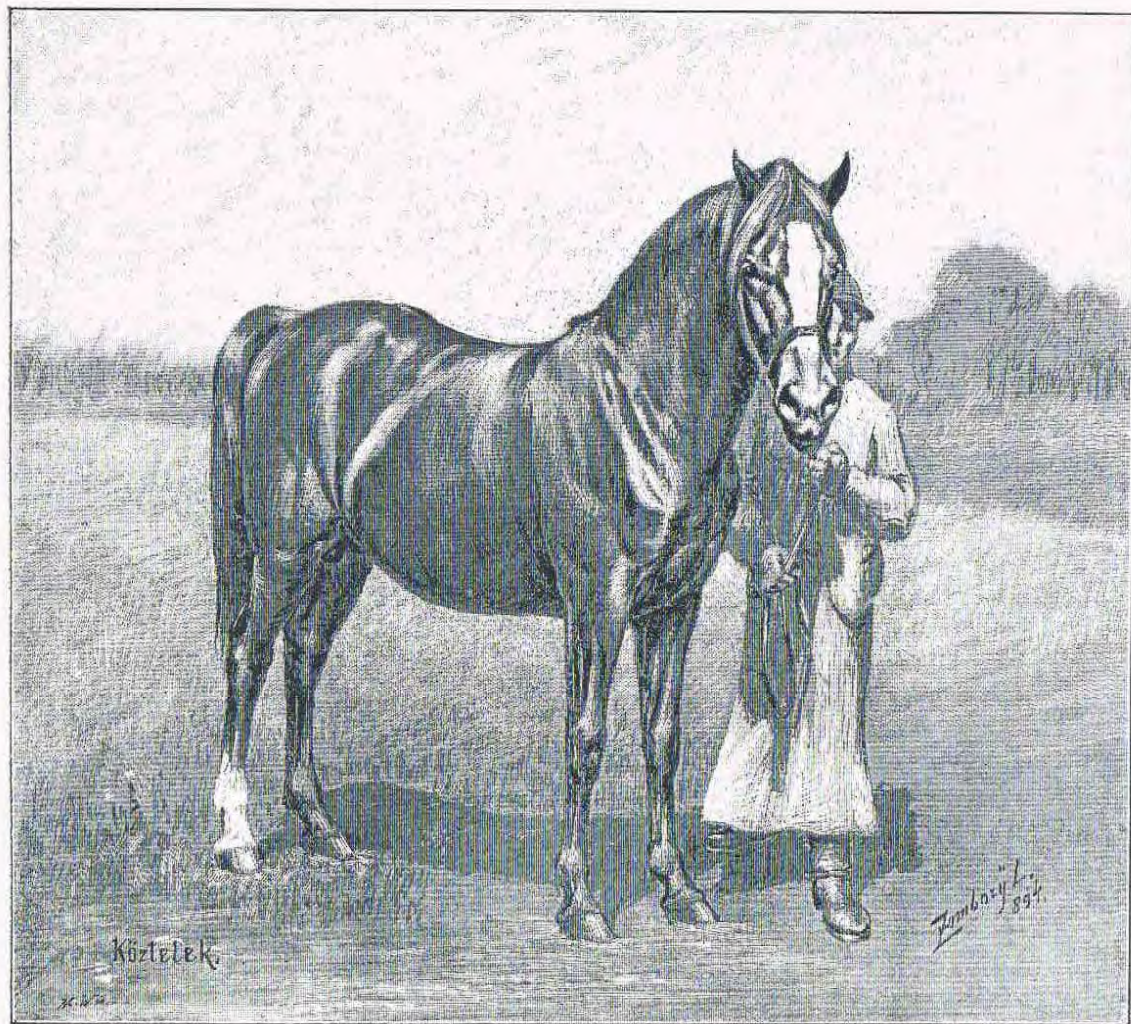

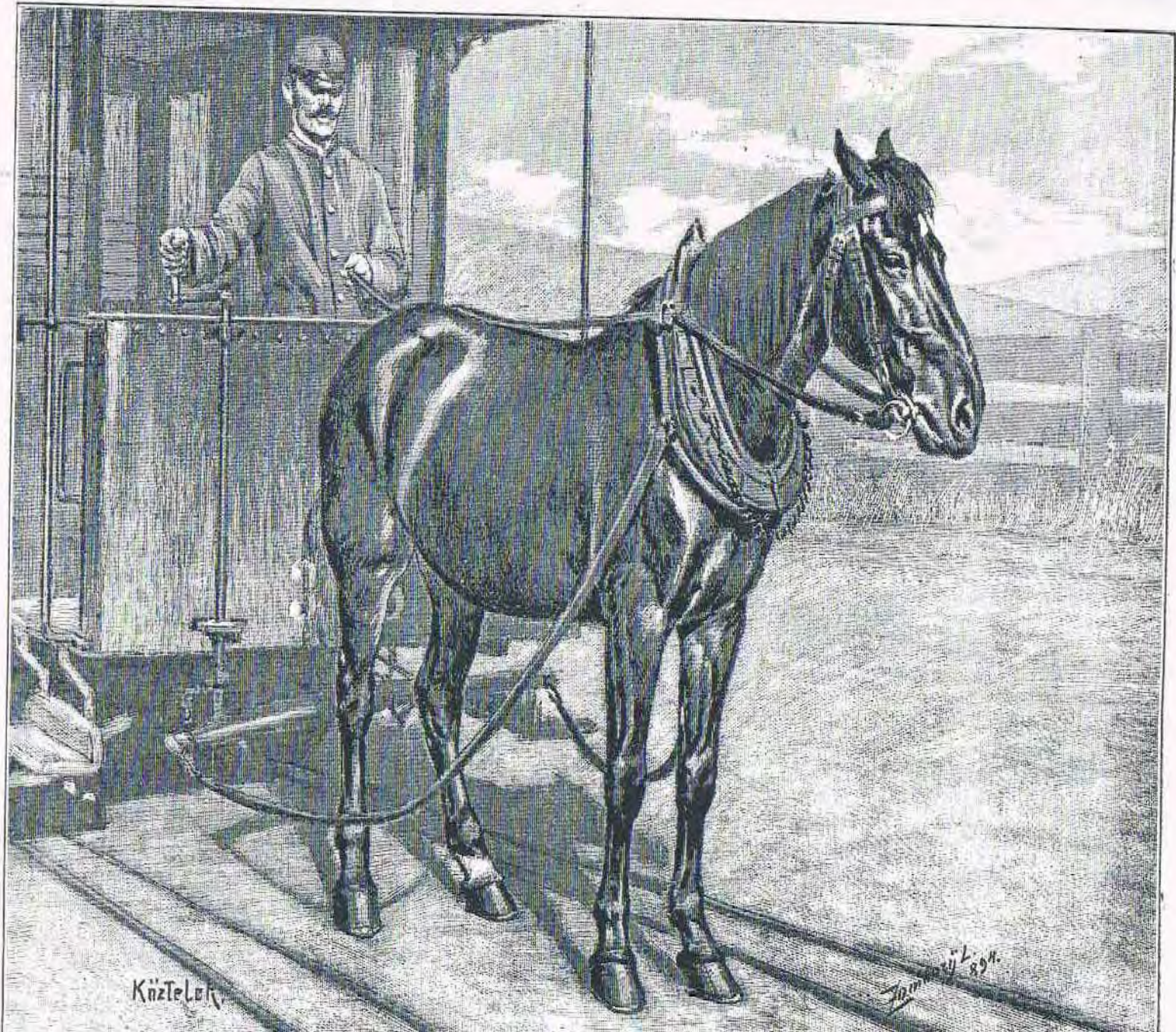

Short history of the breed

- Begins in the Roman Empire (Noricum province)
- Alpine region (middle – west – east)
- Noriker (A) – Freiburger (Franche Montagne)
(CH) – Murinsulaner
- Mura river belongs to four countries
- Decline of the breed
- Reconstruction of Murinsulaner

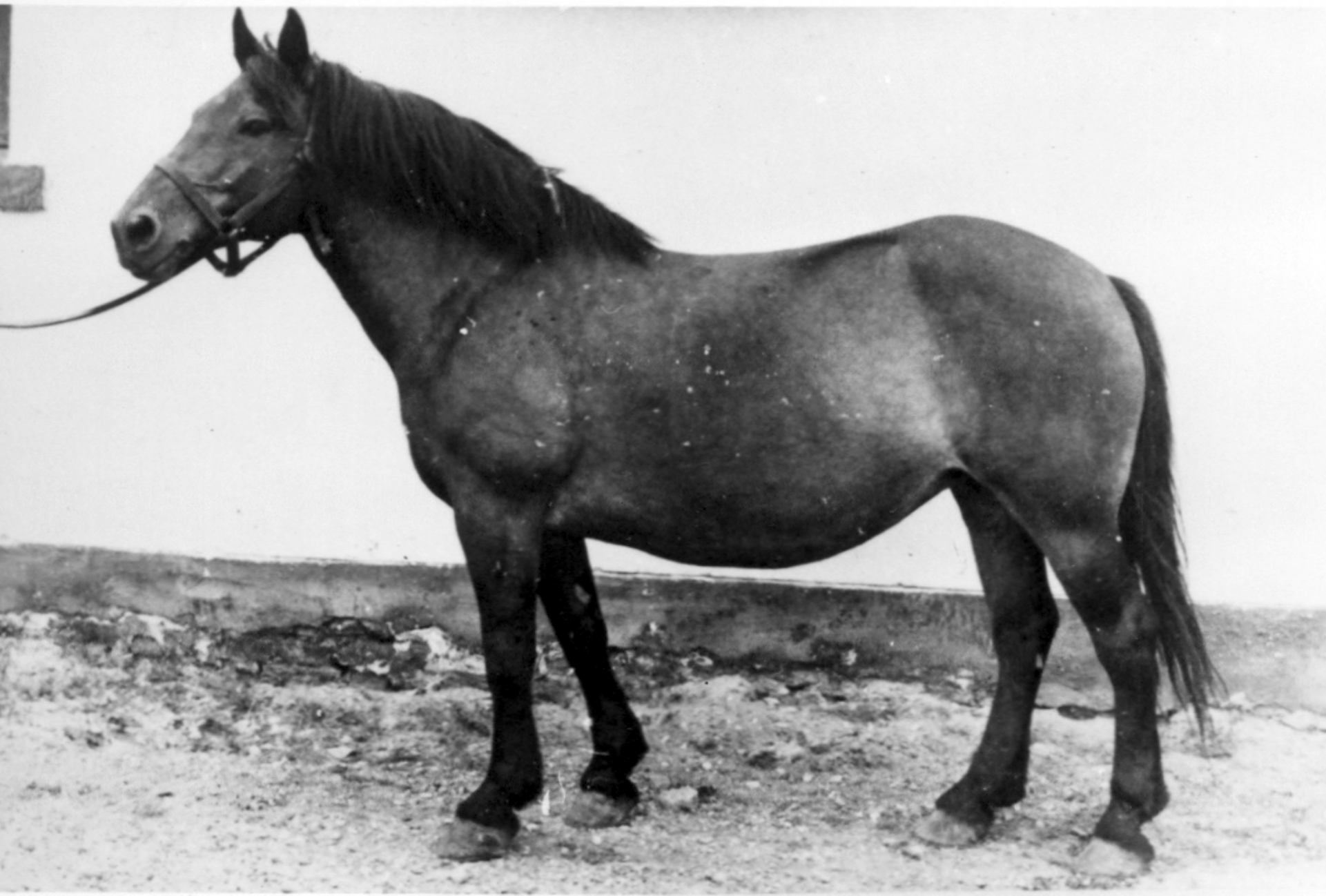

Useful characteristics of the breed

- Conformation: differs from other cold blooded horses
- Smaller size: less expensive keeping
- Beauty: attractive in tourism
- Faster: good in work, more economic in work
- Working ability: agriculture and tourism (show the traditional agricultural work, ecological farming)
- Reproduction: advantage in meat production
