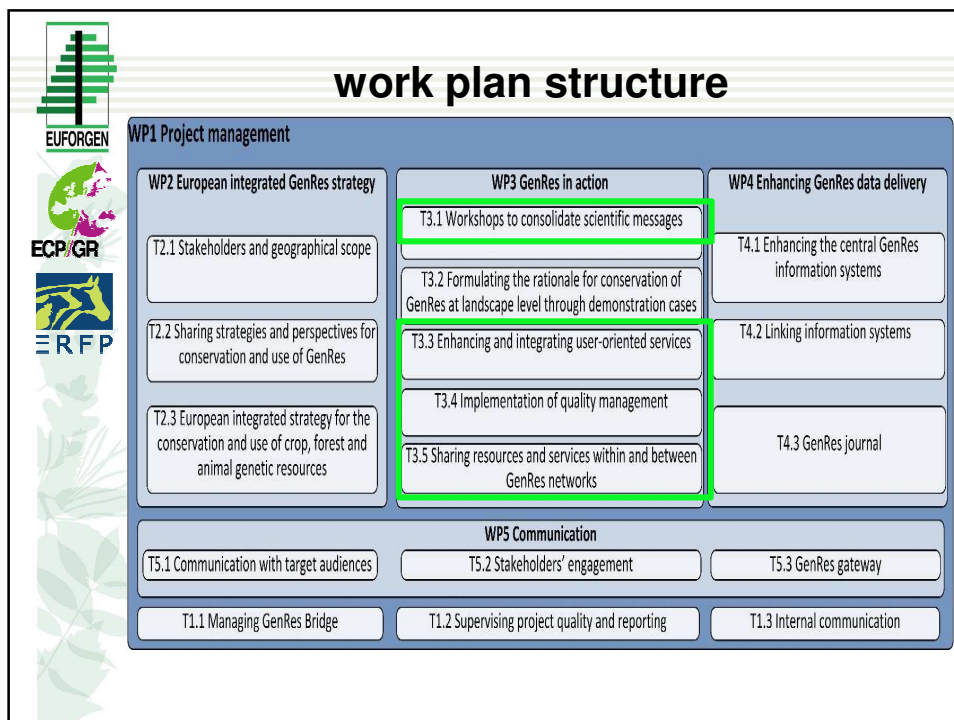
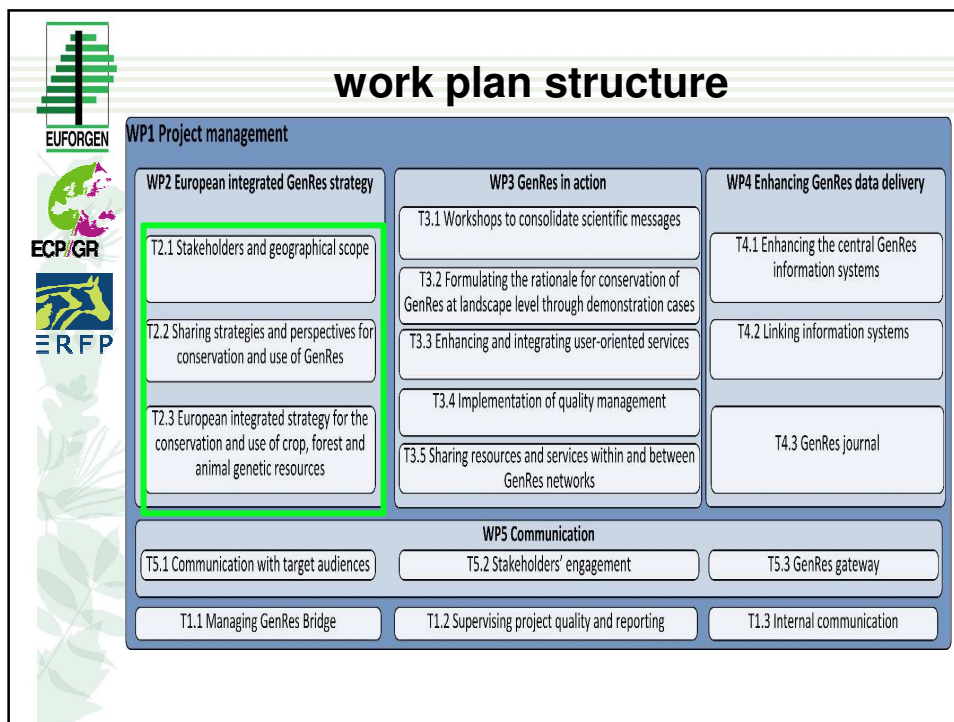


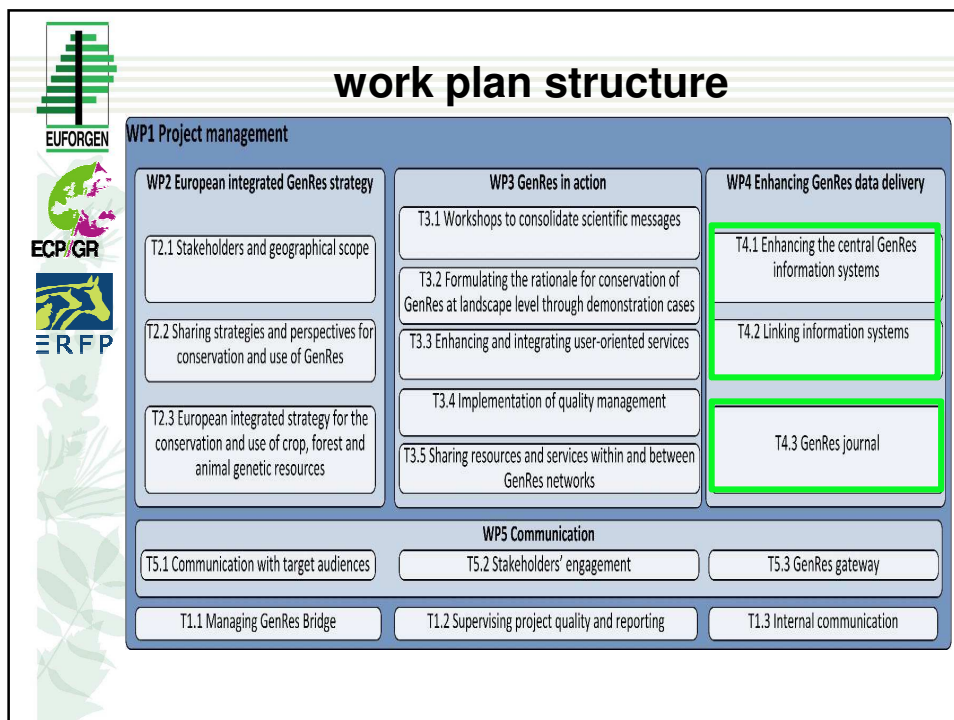


GenRes Bridge Main Objectives

- ✓ **increase the effectiveness** of sustainable management for crop, forest and animal GenRes
- ✓ **widen capacities** to increase the knowledge on conserved diversity of crop, forest and animal GenRes
- ✓ **enhance the conservation** status of GenRes
- ✓ **improve the services** offered to the end-users of GenRes
- ✓ **Develop integrated conservation strategy** for (forest, animal and crop) genetic resources in Europe
 - ✓ Missing: Formal EU framework for Agrobiodiversity/Genetic Resources conservation and use
- ✓ Present outcomes at **high-level policy events**
