

 To represent, manage and defend the interests of its Member Organizations, both in Spain and abroad



















• FEAGAS collaborates with public bodies/institutions, universities, research centers, etc. for the conservation, breeding, management and sustainable use of the Spanish Livestock Breeds.







• FEAGAS organizes the participation of the Spanish Livestock Breeds in the national and international purebred exhibitions, officially approved by Ministry of Agriculture.

A) Establish the goals for the breeds (conservation, breeding and promotion) and in charge of its management.

B) Implement the Breeding Programme officially approved for each breed.

C) Report, as required by the competent authority, on the actions carry out in the implementation of its Breeding Programme.

D) Guarantee access to its data bases, with the form and conditions determined by the competent authority, and report information to the National **Database for Livestock Breeds** (ARCA).

E) Carry out the programme for the dissemination of the improvement of its breed.



2. Main concerns/problems of the livestock sector

 A big part of the scientific research is not related to the real problems of the livestock sector:



- ✓ Adaptation to the environment and resistance to illness.
- ✓ Cover the future demands of the consumers, focusing on those products
- ✓ that may change in the future.
- ✓ Determination of genes of interest.
- ✓ Technological innovations that allows an easier and cheaper handling.
- ✓ Management improvement, etc.

 Publics Bodies do not soundly prioritize research projects that may have a huge impact on the Livestock Sector.











Improve the profitability of the farms through better policies of marketing (allow people to get more information about livestock products) and exportations.

3. Solutions to answer the need of prioritization of the projects that meets a real need of the sector.


Establishment from the public bodies of priority areas for investigation in line with the needs of the livestock sector. (European system)

Swap research funds from the universities to the purebred associations, allowing these organizations to focus the research in their main topics of interest and to choose the best research entity for their needs.

3. Solutions to answer the need of prioritization of the projects that meets a real need of the sector.



Include people from the purebred livestock sector in the

evaluation committee for the approval of research projects

(INIA RZ/AnGR)

- It is essential to work with the same aproach to take avantage of working together.
- The AnGR cannot be seen only from a point of view/perspective.
- It is necessary not only to exchange ideas but to set up a formal place where regularly bring together positions.
- Actions like the lunching of the branding Local Breed 100% is a clear example of a coordinated support/effort to the AnGR.
