## The French Award



- Created in 2002
- Awarding farmers or associations
- Project to be sent = 5 pages template
- Jury = panel of genetic resources experts + donators
- Funding = CEVA (vet lab) + individual sponsor
  - First prize = 10 000 €
  - Second prize = 6 000 €
  - Third prize = 4 000 €

## Judgement criteria



1. Each judge grades according to **four** criteria:
  - Economic value of the project (7 points)
  - Social and/or environmental impact of the project on a given territory (7 points)
  - Awareness-raising and/or communication actions on a breed to be preserved (4 points)
  - Quality of presentation of the template (2 points)
2. The jury meets to analyse the 10 best projects according to the individual grading and gives a new notation for each finalist after hearing each other's opinions.

## Logistics: Fondation du Patrimoine



- Launching the calls (including press release)
- Receive the proposals from the candidates
- First sorting of the proposals by excluding the ones that do not fit the criteria (main exclusion item: not a rare breed)
- Organization of the jury meeting and deliberation
- Organization of the award ceremony and press release
- Other communication tools: finding a patron for the ceremony; banners; videos; social media...

## Examples of winning projects

- 2021 winner: **Bleue du Nord**  
Transboundary cattle breed.  
Project: creation of a "Bleue du Nord" brand

Winning points:

- Dairy development of a mixed breed with low numbers in its territory,
- Number of players involved and the collective dimension of the project,
- Various benefits (economic, heritage, environmental and social) envisaged

## Examples of winning projects

- 2017 winner: **Sasi Ardi**  
Transboundary sheep breed.  
Project: Conservation and development of the breed  
Economic development of two typical local meat products  
Cross-border cooperation with Spanish Sasi Ardi breeders

Winning points:

- Sustainable economic project, based on the support of the breeders and the promotion of two typical products
