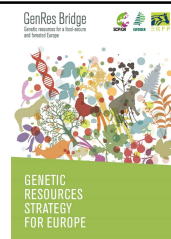

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## GRSE - Follow-up process at EU level

- **EU Council Working Party meeting of 20 June 2022** dedicated to GR Strategy for Europe  
*“DG Agri considered necessary that MS continue the work to better integrate GR into the existing strategies of the EU, in particular in environmental policies. It encourages the MS to continue their work with a view to inviting the Commission to develop this strategy.”*
- **EU Council Working Party meeting of 8 May 2023** (Swedish Presidency)  
 EU Member States were asked again to give their opinion on the need for development of a Strategy for GR, a policy and legal framework for GR, at EU level. And moreover, the need for establishing an EU Coordination and Information Centre for GR.
- No further initiative of EC yet on this matter
- Small group of ECPGR and ERFP representatives discussed how to inform/facilitate the political process towards an EU GR Strategy and establishment of ECIC. Group asked legal advice on possible legal framework for ECIC.
