

Number of endangered breeds in your country





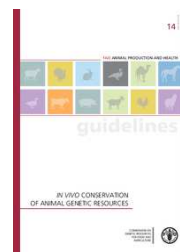
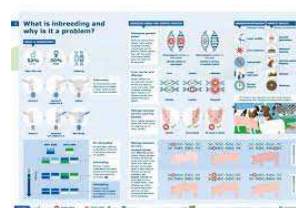

- Suggestions and advise towards harmonisation of:
 - Minimum criteria for classification of a breed as “endangered breed”
 - Parameters/indicators for assessing breed risk status and genetic health (demographic, genetic, socio-economic, etc)
