Mediterranean Joint Workshop

The meeting started with a short introduction presenting the aims of the session (ppt attached), followed by a quick survey to gather participants responses on the main gaps (attached the questions and responses). The 3 more frequent responses are marked in light blue (score 7, 6 and 5).

The <u>Breeders Association</u> (lack or weak) was the most frequent response (7 out of the 15 responded), followed by the <u>lack of funding</u> (6 /15) and <u>absence of National Plan</u> and lack of <u>cooperation</u> (5 /15).

The short discussion focussed on the main tools to reinforce cooperation in the region. The organization of the regional (Mediterranean) EAAP Workshop every 2 years was one of the means suggested and agreed. Other suggestions the organization of webinars (within EAAP) and the utilization of the EAAP website (i.e. to enhance the exchanges within the region (research, breeders). The role of the ERFP WG docu info was stressed (how to assist in improving the communication and exchange within the region, i.e. by sharing tools). EAAP (through the President, Isabel Casasus) expressed its support
