



Report of the Ad Hoc workshop on Small Ruminant Semen Cryopreservation, Uppsala, Sweden, June 2025

1. Objectives (Summary)

Many people who are trying to cryopreserve semen from small ruminants are working in isolation. The objective of this workshop was to bring together people with practical experience of the subject to exchange techniques and ideas. In addition, we wanted to build a network of researchers with similar interests.

Phantom for rams works quite well, especially for some rams that do not like people in their proximity.

4. The main result was a good exchange of information between the participants on various topics. In particular, participants could exchange practical tips and discuss problems that they had encountered. Everybody agreed that this was a good forum for information exchange. It is intended to prepare a manuscript for publication in *Genetic Resources* so that other people can also benefit from the expertise presented.

5. Plan

The participants expressed a wish to have more workshops. They expressed a preference for a "in person" workshop rather than digitally, but they all agreed that some form of communication is better than none at all. It would be desirable to have a contact list of experts available e.g. via the ERFP website, for further consultation.
