Collection of semen from locally adapted breeds in Serbia -project implementation news-

- The project started in December 2023;
- Duration of the project 18 m;
- Implementation by: Public Enterprise Livestock Veterinary Center for Reproduction and Arteficial Insemination, Velika Plana (EUGENA member Gene Bank);
- Semen will be produced and conserved with the agreement on mutual rights and obligations concluded with the owners of the animals;

- Project goal: Semen collection of the 7 (seven) LAB: Busha cattle, Podolian cattle, Domestic buffalo, Domestic-mountain pony, Nonius, Lipizzaner and Balkan donkey;
- Three heads of each breed were to be used for semen production;
- It is planned to obtain 1000 doses of semen from each head;
- Semen production and conservation will be in accordance with the Law on Livestock Breeding and the Law on Veterinary;

Problems during project implementation:

- small number of males with HB numbers;
- when testing potential donors, positive results were obtained for IBR;
- bad epizootiological situation in Serbia, semen collection takes place in natural conditions (African swine fever outbreaks appeared and movement in certain areas was prohibited, there is currently an increased risk of Foot-and-Mouth disease);
- During 2024, there were extremely high temperatures that caused the loss of the copulatory reflex of semen donor animals;

Progress has been made in such difficult working conditions;

- 3000 doses were collected from 3 male donors of Podolian cattle (finished task);
- 1000 doses were collected from 1 male donor of Busha cattle (task not finished);
- Semen from Domestic buffalo, Domestic-mountain pony, Nonius, Lipizzaner and Balkan donkey are not yet collected. The animals donor are only identified (task not finished);
- Due to the stated justified reasons, the SVC requested an extension of the project implementation by another
 24 m
